- ✓ DOT approved helmet, plus eye protection
- ✓ Durable jacket (leather or jean preferred)
- √ Full length pants (i.e. blue jeans, etc.)
- ✓ Gloves that cover and protect the wrists and fingertips
- ✓ Motorcycle or rubber soled boots that cover your ankles (no cowboy boots, no leather soles). Steel toed boots will be accepted, however, please note that a steel toed boot can hinder your ability to use the foot-shift lever on the motorcycle.

Students should:

- ✓ Bring a lawn chair
- \checkmark Try to be at the course 10 15 minutes before the course start time
- ✓ Bringing rain gear is always a good idea. So is sunscreen and bug spray.
